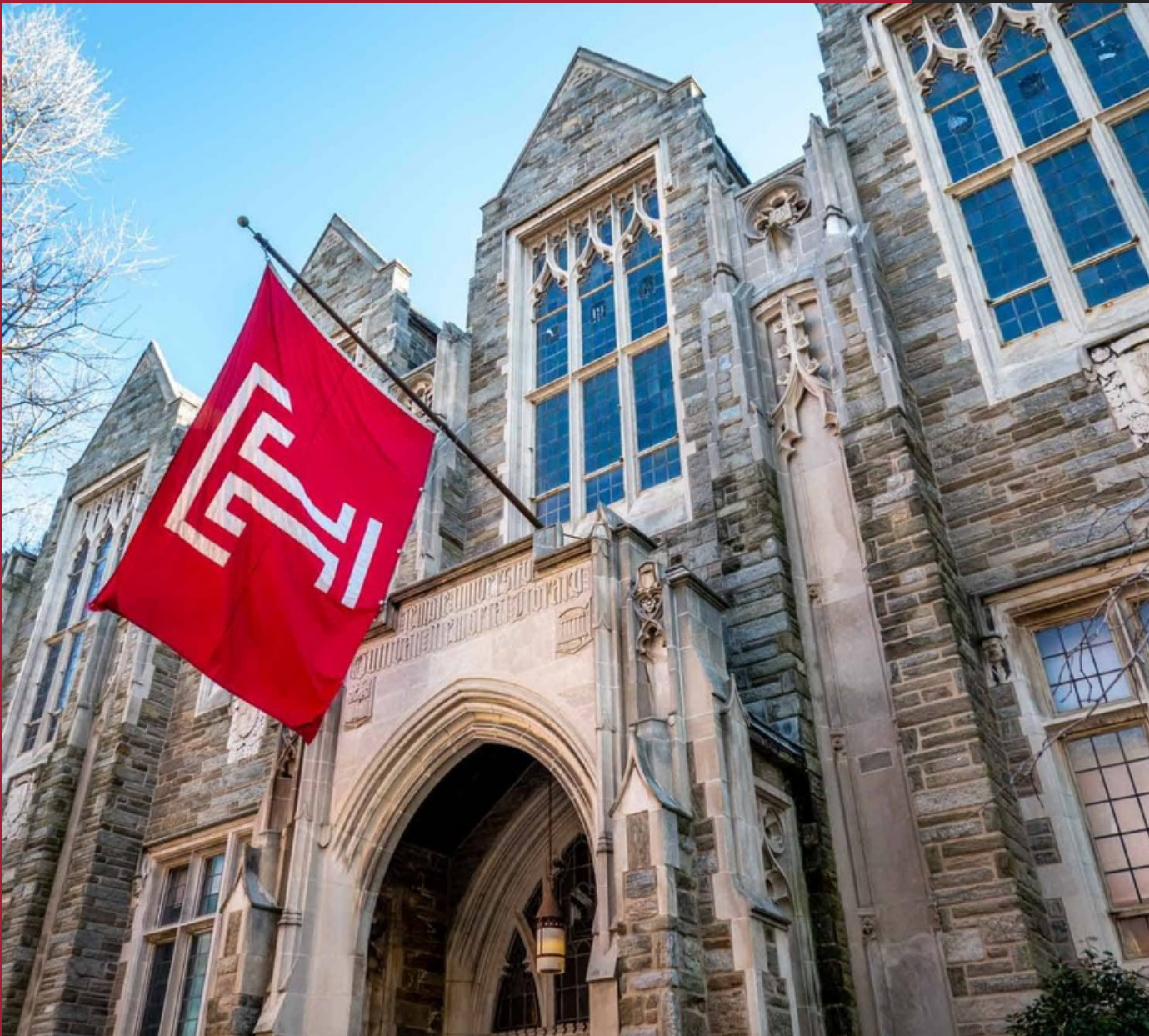

Outreach Programs

PRE-COLLEGE INITIATIVE (PCI)

\$2,000

It provides mentorship, STEM activities, college readiness programs, and exposure to engineering careers to build a strong pipeline of future engineers.
